AS 3789.10-2025 Healthcare Facilities and Institutions - Blankets

The Australian Standard AS 3789.10-2025 adopts a performance based approach for assessment of a blankets' suitablility for use in a medical or institutionalised setting.

Each construction type is assessed using methods appropriate to its structure, and compliance looks at a number of core performance requirements, strength testing and colourfastness testing for coloured products.



Performance requirements

Dimensional stability: Products are required to meet minimum dimensions after either 5 commercial washing

cycles or 5 laboratory hot wash / tumble dry cycles.

Pilling: Fabrics are tested to ISO 12945-1, tumbling in a pillbox for 14,400 cycles (4 hours).

> Rating is assigned on a 1- 5 scale, where 5 = no change and 1 = significant pilling observed. The specification requires a minimum rating of 3-4 for all products.

Thermal resistance: While the standard does not specify a minimum compliance, suggested values are

provided as a guideline for suppliers.

Strength testing: The tensile strength and tearing resistance of woven blankets is measured. Knitted

blankets are assessed based on the bursting pressure.

Colourfastness: The fastness to washing, water and perspiration is assessed on all coloured blankets.

> Rating is assigned on a 1- 5 scale, where 5 = no change and 1 = significant staining or colour change observed. The specification requires a minimum rating of 4 for all tests.

Flammability: Where a fire hazard is identified, flammability of the blankets is assessed to BS 7175, The

ignitability of bedcovers and pillows by a smouldering or flaming ignition source, after 5

laboratory hot wash / tumble dry cycles.

Hygiene: Where infection risk management is required, and users are not able to guarantee

disinfection during the cleaning process, suppliers may wish to test the blankets for their

antimicrobial properties.
